- While parents can offer guidance at home, it's essential that students complete their work independently in their own handwriting.

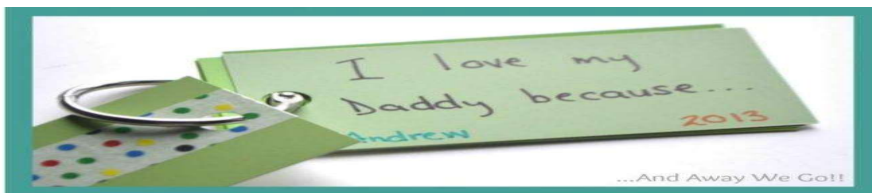
Let's begin this adventure of discovery and creativity!

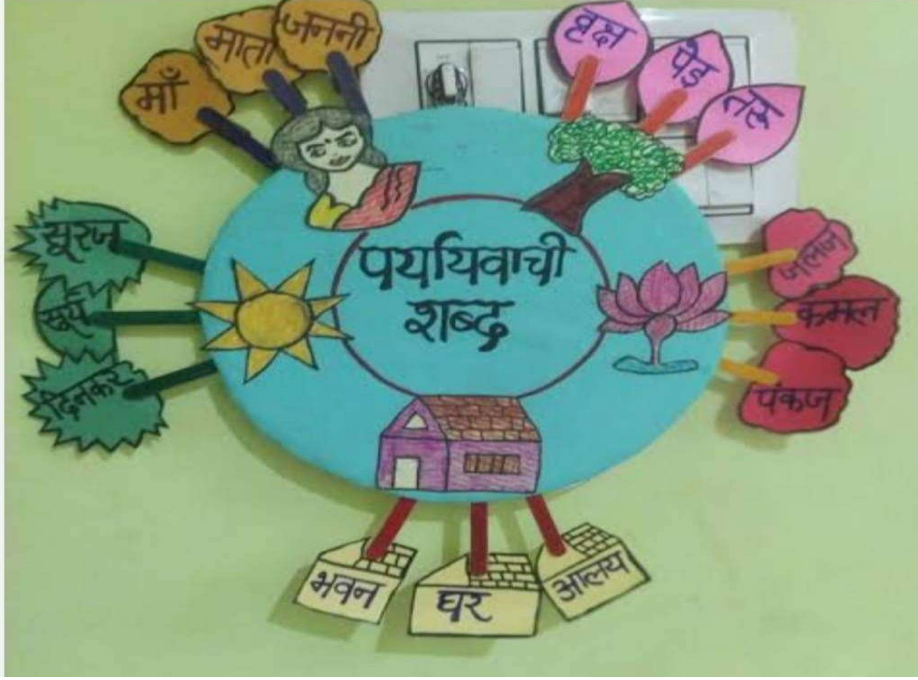

- Write its number name, expanded form and place values

2. Fun with Roman Numeral

For roll no. 1-20

- Make a wall clock model using Roman numeral (I – XII)

- Label the clock parts (hour and minute hand)
- Give your clock a vintage look

- Make a 3D cube calendar showing Roman numerals for the date, month and year
- Three cubes – one each for date (I – XXXI), month (I – XII), year digits (MMXXV i.e. 2025)

- Make a daily routine timeline
- Draw clocks for 4 key times of your day
- Cut and paste photos/drawings for each activity
- Roll and tie it like a museum scroll
- Use thick pastel sheet or cloth to make a scroll and show your creativity

5. Symmetry Art

- Create the art of symmetrical patterns
- Use folded paper painting, paper cutting or rangoli designs
- Show the line of symmetry clearly drawn and paste it on A4 size sheet

6. Word problems

- Create 2 of your word problems from your real life (Addition & Subtraction)
- Solve them and give each a title, like 'The bus ride' etc.

1. Draw any two constellations on A4 Sheet. Use innovative ideas to represent the position of star.
2. Let's be a part of this Environment Day celebration and make a bird feeder from the waste materials. Suggestive materials (Old cartons, coconut shells, reuse disposable jars etc.)
